

Section 2. Respondent Demographics by Firm and Fee Earners

The majority of firms are midsize firms, with the highest concentration of firms having 21 to 40 lawyers (25.9%). Following closely are firms with 9 to 20 lawyers (22.4%) and 41 to 75 lawyers (21.6%). Nearly two-in-five firms have 76 to 150 lawyers (16.5%). The smallest percentage of firms have over 150 lawyers (4.7%) or 2 to 8 lawyers (9.0%).

The majority of firms consist of a headquarters with branch offices (49.8%), followed by those who have a single office (37.6%). Only a small number of firms have multiple offices in one metro area (2.7%).

Demographics: By Years of Experience, Title, and Primary Practice Area

Over half of fee earners report they have practiced law for 11 years or more (58.3%). Over one-third report having twenty or more years of experience (35.1%). A small number of fee earners have less than 2 years of experience (8.4%).
